

## WARE RIVER YACHT CLUB Virginia Governor's Cup -2024 60th Virginia Governor's Cup Regatta Notice of Race



Saturday, August 3rd & Sunday, August 4th

Host and Organizing Authority: Ware River Yacht Club, Gloucester, Virginia CBYRA Sanctioned.

**Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 and by the event's sailing instructions.

Fees: Registration is \$90 for single crew and \$115 for all two or more crewed classes if preregistered by JULY 1, 2024, via a secure online portal. WRYC can also accept payment by VENMO. For participants registering after July 1, a surcharge of \$15 will be added to the entry fee. Onsite registration will be available Friday August 2<sup>nd</sup> at the higher rate. Regatta T-shirts are included in the registration fee for all participants, as well as a bag lunch both race days.

## Eligibility and Entry: ALL CLASSES ARE INVITED TO PARTICIPATE

Some of the anticipated One Design classes of 3 or more boats are: Albacore, Buccaneer, Fireball, Hampton OD, Laser & Laser Radial, Mutineer, Mobjack, Optimist, Thistle, and Windmill. Classes with fewer than 3 boats participating will be grouped with other such classes and race under the Portsmouth handicap system. (D-PN).

Governor's Cup Regatta Awards: Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers of all registered classes with 3 boats or more boats. The Governor's Cup trophy is awarded to the winner of the one design class with the largest number of qualified starts in the regatta. The Congressman's Cup trophy is awarded for sportsmanship throughout the regatta weekend. The Chamber of Commerce Cup is awarded to the top participating skipper less than 18 years of age. Lunches will be provided on both Saturday and Sunday; included in the race fee. Breakfast and coffee is provided at a nominal fee each day.
